With this decision, the Regional Council of South Karelia approves the project for funding from the South-East Finland – Russia CBC 2014–2020 Programme.

#### **INTERMEDIATE MEASURES**

The Joint Monitoring Committee (JMC) of the South-East Finland – Russia CBC 2014–2020 Programme has approved the project for funding in its meeting of 26/09/2019, with the final quality score of 135,69 out of maximum of 200,00.

#### CONTENT OF THE PROJECT AND TERMS OF FUNDING

The amount of funding for the project is 471 580,00 euros, at the most, covering 80 % of the eligible costs of the project. The funding granted for the project, the eligible actions, and other terms related to the project funding shall be specified in a separate grant contract, which shall be concluded between the lead partner of the project and the Managing Authority of the Programme.

#### SUMMARY OF THE QUALITY ASSESSMENTS

The proposal is relevant to the objectives of the programme and to the chosen priority. The proposal also promotes the cross-border cooperation and has likely



an impact on the development of the border regions. Overall comment to the application is, that it is not finalised. Project's contribution to programme's objectives, expected results and outputs is not clearly enough described (specific objectives=results of problem analysis). The expected results and impact as well as sustainability of results are not described on sufficient level. The project involves relevant partners. Communication channels and types are mentioned, but communication strategy is evaluated rather weak. Proposed activities are relevant, but the work plan needs to be developed. Total budget is reasonable.
